

REGULAR SEASON AWARDS DECIDED

With the final two games being played Friday, the final 2010 regular season award winners have been determined.

Todd Brown has claimed his first goal scoring title by notching 78 of them this season as a member of the Phantoms. Brown held off Kevin Smith who won the award the past two seasons.

Bob Anderson earns his second scoring title and is the assists leader for the seventh time. Anderson finished with 121 points total and tallied 66 assists to set a new regular season record. Anderson set a league high mark of 62 last year before beating it out this year. Anderson won the scoring title in 2004 as well.

Smith won't be held out of the awards ceremony despite losing out to Brown and Anderson in the scoring departments. Smith tallied nine powerplay goals, clearing the closest competition by three goals. By scoring the most man-advantage goals, Smith earns the first ever Ben Rossi Jewelers powerplay contest.
